 - Where are we going?


Two Basic Worldviews


- Theism there is a God

Barna: Biblical Worldview Held by Only 4% of Adults

NASHVILLE, Tenn. (BP) — Everyone has a worldview, but few have one that is biblical.

That's the conclusion of a national survey by Barna Research, which found that just 4 percent of American adults have a biblical worldview. Additionally, only 9 percent of those categorized as born-again Christians have a biblical worldview. Barna said.

The poll of 2,033 adults was conducted September through November 2003.

"Worldview" is a term used to describe the belief system by which a person understands or makes decisions about the world.



Only 9 percent of born-again Christians have a biblical worldview!

Barna's Definition of a Biblical Worldview

- Absolutes exist and the Bible defines them
- Christ lived a sinless life
- God is the all-powerful and all-knowing Creator of the universe and He still rules it today
- Salvation is by grace and not by works
- Satan is a real being
- Christians have a responsibility to witness
- The Bible is accurate in all of its teachings

Human Manifesto III

- Knowledge of the world is derived by observation and rational analysis
- Humans are an integral part of nature, the result of unguided evolutionary change
- Ethical values are derived from human need and interest as tested by experience
- Life's fulfillment emerges from individual participation in the service of human ideals
- Humans are social by nature and find meaning in relationships
- Working to benefit society maximizes individual happiness






The Expanding Universe




Timelines of History







Evolutionary Worldview Answers


- Where did we come from?










Trilobite Fossil

Living Fossil: Coelacanth Fish




Supposedly extinct since the Cretaceous Period (70 million years ago) until found in 1938 still living

Dinosaur Blood Cells, Soft Fibrous Tissues, and Blood Vessels!




Dinosaur bone supposedly 65 million years old still has "fresh appearance" and elastic tissue!

Why is there Evil and Suffering?

- God gave us free will, therefore some will decide not to be good (we are not robots)
- Because of the sin of Adam and Eve, God cursed the Earth, so now we have:
 - Decay
 - **Thorns**
 - Storms
 - Earthquakes
 - Animals that eat meat



The Fall of Man

- To Adam he said, "Because you listened to your wife and ate from the tree about which I commanded you, 'You must not eat of it,' "Cursed is the ground because of you; through painful toil you will eat of it all the days of your life. It will produce thorns and thistles for you..." Genesis 3:17-18
 - The Fall of Man not only introduced death, God also cursed the creation itself allowing for physical calamities to take place (e.g. tornadoes, floods, etc.). This was a removal of God's complete sustaining power and decay would begin to take place...
 - The after effects of the flood increased the level of physical calamities
